<p>O'Keefe Foundation "THE OAK MEMORIAL 9/11 SCHOLARSHIP"</p>	<p>This scholarship was formed in memory of Firefighter Patrick J. O'Keefe, FDNY Rescue One who was lost at the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001. This is a \$8,000 award available to one of the two qualifying categories of starting over which can either be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>starting over in the United States as a newly arrived immigrant <u>who has become an American citizen</u></i> <li style="text-align: center;">OR • <i>starting over due to the tragic loss of a parent as a result of a violent act.</i> <p>You must be accepted to an accredited college or university. There are no academic requirements. The scholarship award is based primarily on the personal story contained in the essay of 1000 words.
